The most recent incident was on September 14, 2010 at 08:00P.M. at 1459 North Avenue New Rochelle NY 10804: The Petitioner, Catherine Kassenoff, has a history of several miscarriages, and is currently five months pregnant with a high risk pregnancy and taking blood thinners. The Petitioner, states that the Respondent, Allan Kassenoff forcibly took the child, Alexandra Kassenoff out of the child's high chair while the Petitioner was feeding the child, which caused the child to cry. The Petitioner tried to stand in front of the Respondent and Respondent pushed the Petitioner out of the way. 
