Per RN/SCC referral and Cadence schedule, this writer met with Patient to discuss unscheduled appointment today and reason for patient coming to MSK WES and to provide emotional support. Patient stated to writer that husband has some "issues with anger" and pushed patient in her home. Patient fell down across an ottoman and was concerned that she was hurt. Patient stated that their three children did not witness this morning's event when she fell. Patient stated that husband has never hurt their three chil dren. Patient stated that she and her husband had not been arguing this morning, but that their relationship has not been going very well and the family has a lot of stressors. Patient stated that she has gone to the hospital once before when husband became physical with her. Writer provide various resoruces for patient, including various resources for domestic violence and local support such as PACE University Women's Law Center.

Patient has a personal goal of finishing her last chemotherapy treatment and her surgery on Jan 19 2018, and is re-evaluating her relationship. Patient states that currently is dependent on her husband for his salary and insurance and she has taken off work as a lawyer to complete her cancer treatment. Patient plans to

return to work as soon as she can after her surgery in January 2018.

Patient declined a CT scan today at MSK as she was uneasy about receiving more radiation. She did agree to receiving hydration.

Writer reviewed former and current breast cancer diagnoses (2 primaries), treatment and coping strategies, and support system.

Patient reports somewhat adequate social support from friends; family does not live nearby and husband's family is in New Jersey, but is not overly supportive. Coping strategies and patient's feelings were explored and validated by this writer. Writer and patient will meet next week and patient plans to attend Look Good Feel Better/ACs at MSKCC WES on Dec. 12. Writer contacted and reviewed meeting with patient with supervisor. Supervisor concurred with providing information regarding domestic violence to patient.

A three-generation pedigree was obtained by the genetic counselor from patient report, thus cancer diagnoses reported in family members may or may not be accurate. Pedigree generated and scanned to EMR as documentation. The relevant family history includes:

-Paternal aunt - Died from breast cancer at age 51.

-Paternal cousin - Diagnosed with ovarian cancer at age 39 incidentally during c-section. She underwent BSO and no further treatment. She is now in her 60's.

-Paternal cousin - Died from endometrial cancer in her 50's-60's.

-Paternal aunt - Died from leukemia (ALL) at age 53.

Of note, the patient's mother is age 72 without a personal history of cancer and the patient's father died from amyloidosis at age 78.

The Respondent committed the following family offenses against me and/or my children which constitute assault in the second or third degree and harassment in the first or second degree.

The most recent incident was on September 14, 2010 at 08:00P.M. at 1459 North Avenue New Rochelle NY 10804: The Petitioner, Catherine Kassenoff, has a history of several miscarriages, and is currently five months pregnant with a high risk pregnancy and taking blood thinners. The Petitioner, states that the Respondent, Allan Kassenoff forcibly took the child, Alexandra Kassenoff out of the child's high chair while the Petitioner was feeding the child, which caused the child to cry. The Petitioner tried to stand in front of the Respondent and Respondent pushed the Petitioner out of the way. Respondent took the child upstairs to the guestroom, here the Respondent has been sleeping, and barricaded himself in the room with the child. When the Petitioner tried to open the door to feed the child, the Respondent stopped the Petitioner. When the Respondent finally opened the door and Petitioner reached to the child, the Respondent pushed the Petitioner again.
